

Minutes of the Full Council meeting held on Monday 9th April 2018 at 7:30pm at the Parish Office, Great Linford House, 1 St Leger Court, Great Linford, Milton Keynes, MK14 5HA.

1. **Apologies** were received and accepted from Councillors Coker (work), Heale (personal), Macaulay (holiday) and Philips (ill).
2. **Declaration of members' interests** – None.
3. **Minutes of the previous meeting** – It was noted by Cllr Maclean that the meeting on Wednesday 28th March should have stated that it finished at 8:34pm. With this amendment, it was proposed by Cllr Neate and seconded by Cllr Bedford that the minutes **presented a true reflection of the meeting**. This was voted as: 13 for, 0 against and 2 abstentions.

6. **Planning**
 - 6.1. Report on Planning was provided by Cllr Stabler.
 - 6.2. Memorandum on all applications
 - 6.2.1. 18/00223/FUL 1 Yeomans Drive, Blakelands **Discussions**
about the relevant options for reply were carried out by Cllrs. Cllr Stabler was provided with comments and a suggested direction which he could represent as GLPC's considerations, should this planning application be reviewed at the next DCC meeting.
 - 6.2.2. 18/00812/FUL 14 Ramsons Avenue, Conniburrow **Comment**
was proposed by Cllr Stabler that the MKC Private Housing Unit should inspect the property to provide a report to the Planning Officer on the property's status. This was seconded by Cllr Bedford and voted as: 13 for, 0 against and 2 abstentions.
 - 6.2.3. 18/00773/FUL 9 Milfoil Avenue, Conniburrow **No objection**
was proposed by Cllr Stabler and seconded by Cllr Neate this voted as: 14 for, 0 against and 1 abstention.
 - 6.2.4. 18/00685/FUL Madison House, Michigan Drive, Tongwell **Actions required**
No objection would be proposed unless, as stated by Cllr Calverley, there is a requirement for specific conditions for the parking of HGVs. Cllr Stabler will review this and, if required, would discuss it with the Highways Department and then an objection would be made. This action was proposed by Cllr Calverley and seconded by Cllr Burgess. This was voted as: 12 for, 0 against and 3 abstentions.

7. Topic : Strategic Vision

A presentation was made by Cllr Crooks. The Strategic Report and medium-term finances were circulated prior to the meeting.

After the presentation, attendees were divided into groups and asked to consider the following:

- If we drew a map of the Parish in 15 years' time, what would it look like?

- If not, what we can add to the Plan, and what can we do, that will equip us better?
