New Residential Development Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document Page 94 4.10 Residential Amenity Privacy/Back-to-back Distances 4.10.1 a minimum of 22 metres (back to back) or 13.7 metres (rear to flank) must be applied.

This was voted as 16 for 0 against and 0 abstentions

7.1. Cllr Stabler proposed that GLPC should agree to a formal application being made to MKC for the S106 monies allocated from the NEA Area 4 Open Space and Play Area provisions to be used by GLPC to provide the outdoor gym equipment and new artworks incorporating play with education themes. The responsibility for maintenance of the play equipment will be MKCs. This was seconded by Cllr Heale and voted as 15 for 0 against 0 abstention. **ACTION**
